NOTICE is hereby given to the Municipal Electors of the TOWNSHIP OF BROCK

WHEREAS more candidates have been nominated to each of the following offices than the number required to fill such offices:

OFFICES FOR WHICH VOTING IS TO BE HELD

<u>MAYOR:</u>	One (1) Member to be elected by general vote;
<u>REGIONAL COUNCILLOR:</u>	One (1) Member to be elected by general vote;
<u>WARD COUNCILLORS:</u>	One (1) Member to be elected in WARD ONE (1) One (1) Member to be elected in WARD THREE (3) One (1) Member to be elected in WARD FOUR (4) One (1) Member to be elected in WARD FIVE (5)

ENGLISH LANGUAGE DURHAM DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD

One (1) Trustee to be elected to represent the combined area of the Townships of Uxbridge and Brock

ENGLISH LANGUAGE DURHAM CATHOLIC DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD

One (1) Trustee to be elected to represent the combined area of the Townships of Uxbridge, Scugog, and Brock

**FRENCH LANGUAGE CATHOLIC DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD/

One (1) Trustee to be elected to represent the combined areas of the Cities of Oshawa and Pickering, the Towns of Ajax and Whitby, and the Townships of Brock, Uxbridge, and Scugog

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996, as amended, Council has enacted By-law Number 1994-2006-AP to authorize an alternative voting method known as **VOTE BY MAIL**.

Between **October 16 - 20, 2006** a **VOTE BY MAIL KIT** will be forwarded to each person who has qualified to be on the Voters' List by Canada Post. The VOTE BY MAIL KIT will contain a voting instruction sheet, a composite ballot, ballot secrecy envelope, a voter declaration form, an outer return envelope (yellow) with prepaid postage.

Persons who do not receive a VOTE BY MAIL KIT by October 27, 2006 may obtain a kit at the Township of Brock Municipal Administration Building, 1 Cameron Street East, Cannington, Ontario, L0E 1E0 at the times noted below.

Voting will take place in the following manner:

BY MAIL, the voter:

- upon receipt of the VOTE BY MAIL KIT, shall complete the ballot, place it in the ballot secrecy envelope and seal the envelope;
- shall complete the voter declaration form and place it, together with the sealed ballot secrecy envelope in the yellow prepaid return envelope.

The last date to mail the yellow prepaid return envelope to guarantee delivery is Friday, November 3, 2006.

BY BALLOT RETURN STATION

Voters who choose not to use the mail may deposit their ballots at the Ballot Return Station located at the Township of Brock Municipal Administration Office on the dates and times indicated below:

- **Monday, October 23, 2006 to Friday, November 10, 2006 - 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., excluding Saturdays and Sundays;**
- **Tuesday, November 7, 2006 & Thursday, November 9, 2006 from 6:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.**
- **Monday, November 13, 2006 - 8:30 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.**

- **In addition, ballots may be deposited at the mail drop box located at the front entrance of the Township of Brock Municipal Administration Office at any time until 8:00 p.m., Monday, November 13, 2006.**

No **PROXY** or **ADVANCE VOTING PROVISIONS** other than **BALLOT RETURN STATIONS** are applicable as the Municipal Election is being conducted in accordance with By-law Number 1994-2006-AP.
