

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BROCK

BY-LAW NUMBER 2108-2007-AP

BEING A BY-LAW TO DELEGATE CERTAIN MATTERS UNDER THE MUNICIPAL ACT, S.O. 2001, AS AMENDED, AND THE PLANNING ACT, R.S.O. 1990, AS AMENDED, PURSUANT TO SECTION 23.2 OF THE MUNICIPAL ACT, S.O. 2001, AS AMENDED

WHEREAS section 23.2 of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, as amended, authorizes municipalities to delegate certain legislative and quasi-judicial powers under the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, as amended, and the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, to an individual who is an officer, employee, or agent of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Brock deems it expedient to delegate its power to temporarily close a highway under the jurisdiction of the Township of Brock to its Director of Public Works and/or designate;

AND WHEREAS sections 22(6.1) and 34(10.4) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, specifies that Council shall, within 30 days, notify an applicant whether or not the application, fees, prescribed information, and other information and material required in support of an development application is complete;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Brock deems it expedient to delegate its power to deem a development application as complete to its Clerk-Administrator and/or designate;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Brock enacts as follows:

1. THAT the Director of Public Works of the Corporation of the Township of Brock or his/her designate may temporarily close any highway or any portion of a highway for any period during the construction, repair or improvement of the highway or any portion of highway where such construction, repair or improvement is initiated by the Township of Brock or is initiated by a utility company with statutory rights or an access agreement with the Township of Brock permitting occupancy of the highway.
2. THAT the Director of Public Works of the Township of Brock or his/her designate may temporarily close any highway or any portion of a highway for any period due to a situation which would endanger traffic and/or the public.
3. THAT the Director of Public Works of the Township of Brock or his/her designate may approve a temporary closure of any highway or any portion of a highway to facilitate a social, recreational, community, athletic, or cinematographic purpose, or any combination thereof, or any other similar purpose.
4. THAT the Clerk-Administrator of the Township of Brock or his/her designate may determine whether an application submitted pursuant to sections 22 and 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, is complete and to notify an applicant that an application is complete in accordance with section 22(6.1) or 34(10.4) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.
5. THAT By-law Number 1856-2004-PW, being a by-law to delegate the power of Council to temporarily close a highway, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

6. THAT this by-law shall come into force and effect on the date it is passed by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Brock.
