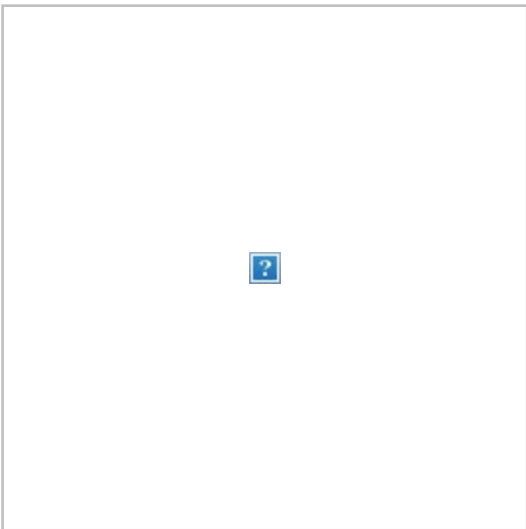

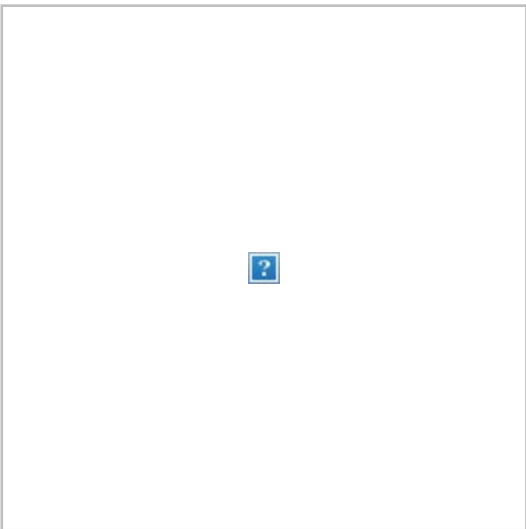

A new report estimates 55 per cent of municipal assets are in a state of good repair, with the remaining 45 per cent not in a state of good repair.

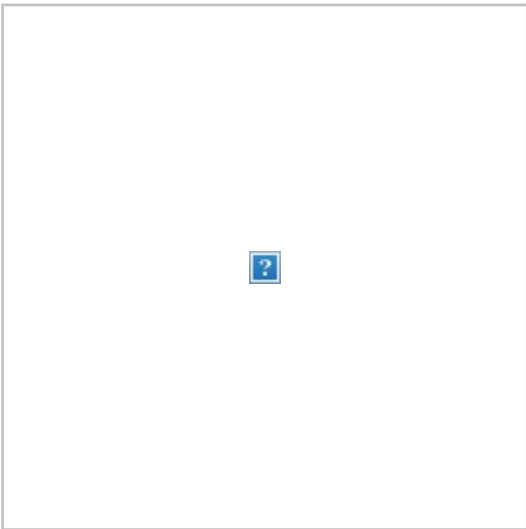

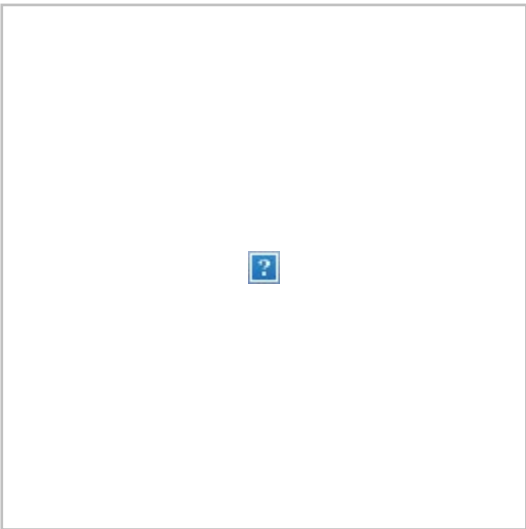
