## **Skateboard Park Policy**

### 1.0 Purpose

The purpose of the Skateboard Park Policy is to provide a set of consistent guidelines for ensuring safe and responsible use of skateboard park facilities.

The policy applies to the public who use the Beaverton, Cannington and Sunderland skateboard parks.

### 2.0 Management

#### 2.1 Supervision

Township of Brock Skateboard Parks are unsupervised. It is strongly recommended that children under the age of 14 be accompanied by an adult at all times.

#### 2.2 Hours of Use

The hours of use are restricted to the hours between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.

The facility is to be used during fair weather conditions.

#### 2.3 BMX and Stunt Bicycles

The use of any bicycle is not recommended. Only plastic pegs are recommended to be used.

## 2.4 Emergencies

Know what to do in an emergency.

Skateboarding accidents happen, so you should always know what to do in emergency situations. Don't panic. Call 911 for medical assistance.

#### 2.5 Graffiti

Graffiti will not be removed provided it does not contain foul language, obscenities, gang related tags or any change to the surfacing making it slippery and unsafe.

#### 2.6 Inspections

Inspections will be performed by a competent staff person.

Detailed inspections will be conducted weekly and findings will be recorded on an inspection form specific to each facility, dated and signed.

Deficiencies will be corrected as soon as possible.

Inspection reports will be kept at the arena facility.

Inspection reports will be reviewed annually in an attempt to identify trends and areas of concern.

#### 3.0 Maintenance

A comprehensive maintenance program shall be in place for each skateboard park facility as a whole.

Maintenance shall include but not be limited to:

- Remove all hazardous debris and litter from the entire skateboard park area and dispose in the appropriate manner
- Check drains for clearing of leaves and debris
- Tighten nuts, bolts and connectors as required
- Voids in surfacing must be repaired

Concrete parks shall be re-sealed within 2 years after construction. At that time Pentra-Sil must be used to treat the surface.
