The Township of Brock is offering a Low-Income Seniors Rebate Program to assist low income seniors who own and occupy residential homes within the borders of the Township of Brock.

A Property Tax Rebate of \$350.00 is available to taxpayers who meet the following requirements:

1. The Taxpayer is a minimum age of 65 years of age or older
2. The Taxpayer's annual income must qualify for the receipt of the Guaranteed Income Supplement, provided under the Old Age Security Act (GIS – Canada) **;
Applicant must provide a copy of their GIS Renewal award letter for the year being applied for which is sent in July/August of each year.
3. The Taxpayer must own and occupy the property as a principal residence
4. **The Taxpayer must complete the application and ensure it is received by the Township of Brock by September 30th of each year.**

Personal information on this form is obtained under the authority of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, and will be used to determine eligibility for a rebate on the property taxes paid to the municipality. If you satisfy all the requirements, a \$350.00 Tax Rebate credit will be applied to your tax account at the end of the year being applied for. **Do Not** reduce your payments by this rebate amount or late payment fees will apply to any unpaid balance.

Once you have applied for this rebate an application will automatically be mailed to you annually with your Final Tax billing. **The application for the rebate must still be applied for every year.** If you do not receive an application with your Final billing, please contact the Treasury office to obtain one. **New – visit our new website www.townshipofbrock.ca**, and complete your application online if you have the ability to attach a copy of your GIS renewal letter electronically. Applications filed electronically will receive a reply email as their receipt of submission. ** NOTE: The Guaranteed Income Supplement program is administered by Human Resources Development Canada (HRDC) in conjunction with the Old Age Security Pension.
